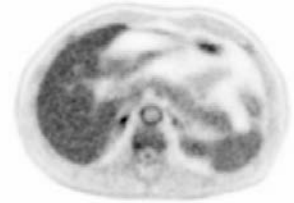
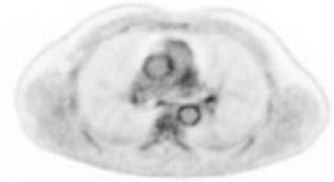


EXPLORER
